About Us

Children of the World Delhi (CWD) is a nonpolitical, secular and not-for-profit NGO, registered under the Societies Registration Act No. XXI of 1860. CWD is recognized as a 'specialized adoption agency' by Central Adoption Resource Authority (CARA), Ministry of Women and Child Development, Government of India.

CWD aims to help abandoned, orphaned and destitute children by way of adoption, sponsorship and community development projects in the Delhi national capital region (NCR).

CWD is committed to the UN Declaration on Children's Rights, specifically their rights to special protection, social and material security, care and positive conditions for growing up.

CWD traces its origins to the Norwegian Korean Association (founded in 1953 during the Korean War) and its subsequent avatar, Children of the World Norway (founded in 1978). CWD Secretary Mrs. Mohini Raghunath, helped in establishing Children of the World Bombay in August 1984, and subsequently, helped in establishing Children of the World Delhi in 1991.

WHAT WE DO

Childcare / Adoption



A residential childcare centre, Mamta is the first port-of-call for children who are lost, rendered homeless, relinquished or abandoned due to poverty, parental deaths or breakdown in family relations.

At Mamta, children are provided round-the-clock care, protection, shelter, medical aid and rehabilitation facilities till such a time that they find a loving home in India or a foreign country.

Over the years, CWD has helped scores of children reunite with their families. We have also helped hundreds of children find loving adoptive families in India and abroad.

Sponsorship



Pragati is a broad-based programme which aims to support children and families from low socio-economic communities. Under Pragati, several programmes such as remedial classes for children, nutritional aid, career and family counseling, and support for Tuberculosis patients are being run in Manglapuri, a low-income urban community in South West Delhi.

Due to COVID-19 pandemic, the centre at Manglapuri was temporarily shut down. However, the social workers continued to provide the children and their families with aid and support (for example - dry rations

and counseling) remotely.

As the year progressed, a series of workshops were conducted for adolescents, which tackled various issues of concern to them. Themes such as gender equality, need for education, etc. were spotlighted during these workshops. The children showed great enthusiasm and keenness to engage and learn in these group interactions.

At CWD, children and staff jointly celebrated all national festivals such as Rakshabandhan, Holi, Eid, Independence Day, Dussehra, Diwali, Christmas and Republic Day with great enthusiasm.

MAMTA - ADOPTION PROGRAMME

Mamta is the residential child care centre of CWD. It provides care and protection to destitute, abandoned and unwanted children in the age group zero to six years.

The main objective of Mamta is to look after children who need not only immediate shelter and protection but also long-term rehabilitation through adoption and foster care. Efforts are made to restore the child to its biological family, failing which, the child is put up for adoption or foster care.

Children are admitted to Mamta by the order of the Child Welfare Committee (CWC). At the time of admission, children are often in a state of trauma and require immediate medical attention and psychological counseling. Each child under our custody undergoes a thorough medical examination. We maintain detailed Medical Examination Reports (MERs) and Child Study Reports (CSRs) of each child. Dr. Sricha Sharma, our consulting pediatrician, takes care of all health-related issues, including regular checkups and immunization of our children.

Mamta is equipped to provide quality, all-round care for infants, toddlers, older children and

children with special needs. Great attention is paid to keep the residential environment clean. The food menu is planned to provide balanced nutrition and taste for all children of ages.

For newborns and toddlers, a variety of activities are in place to enhance their mental and physical development. Older children who are enrolled in school were unable to attend physical classes due to COVID-19 Pandemic. They were attending online classes with the support of office staff.

Sometimes, children with special needs are also admitted into Mamta. These children are looked after with special care. Rehabilitative therapies are provided to them. Although, they are largely considered 'unadoptable' as they don't find favor with prospective adoptive parents in India.

We are grateful to our band of dedicated volunteers that help us plan exciting and interesting activities for the children on a regular basis.
