About Us

Children of the World Delhi (CWD) is a non-political, secular, and not-for-profit NGO, registered under the Societies Registration Act No. XXI of 1860. CWD is recognized as a 'specialized adoption agency' by Central Adoption Resource Authority (CARA), Ministry of Women and Child Development, Government of India.

It aims to help abandoned, orphaned and destitute children by way of adoption, sponsorship, and community development projects in the Delhi national capital region (NCR).

CWD is committed to the UN Declaration on Children's Rights, specifically their rights to special protection, social and material security, care, and positive conditions for growing up.

Its origins are traced back to the Norwegian Korean Association (founded in 1953 during the Korean War) and its subsequent avatar, Children of the World Norway (founded in 1978).

CWD Founder and Secretary Mrs. Mohini Raghunath helped in establishing Children of the World Bombay in August 1984, and subsequently, helped in establishing Children of the World Delhi in 1991.

WHAT WE DO

Childcare Centre / Adoption





A residential childcare centre, Mamta is the first port of call for babies who are lost, rendered homeless, relinquished, or abandoned due to poverty, parental deaths, or breakdown in family relations. At Mamta, children are provided round-the-clock care, protection, shelter, medical aid, and rehabilitation facilities till such time that they find a loving home in India or a foreign country.

Over the years, CWD has helped scores of children reunite with their families. We have also helped hundreds of children find loving adoptive families in India and abroad.

Community Outreach





Over the years, CWD has made its mission to provide aid to the disadvantaged communities. Through the past two years COVID-19 has affected the lesser privileged classes the most, in terms of livelihood, health and nutrition. Sole bread-winners of the family lost their jobs and were unable to provide

minimal necessities for the family. The second wave of COVID-19 was a tragic and grim time for the said communities. Looking at this, CWD tried to support as many families and individuals possible with dry ration, sanitary items, and masks. 90-100 families were provided with aid for one month.

As a part of an 'Awareness for the adolescents' series, CWD counsellor Ms. Indu Verma facilitated several workshops for the children from our recently paused Sponsorship programme. The session themes included Gender Equality, Right to Education, Family Dynamics, etc. The series was attended by 40-45 children between the ages of 10-18 years over a period of three months. Every session had an interactive segment where the children put forth their doubts, concerns, or questions to the facilitator. In order to make the workshops interesting, all sessions started with an icebreaker activity followed by an informative and interactive session.

At CWD, children and staff jointly celebrated all national festivals such as Holi, Independence Day, Raksha Bandhan, Onam, Diwali, Christmas etc. with great enthusiasm.

MAMTA - ADOPTION PROGRAMME

Mamta is the residential child care centre of CWD. It provides care and protection to destitute, abandoned, and unwanted children in the age group zero to six years.

The main objective of Mamta is to look after children who need not only immediate shelter and protection but also long-term rehabilitation through adoption and foster care. Efforts are made to restore the child to its biological family, failing which; the child is put up for adoption or alternative care.

Children are admitted to Mamta by the order of the Child Welfare Committee (CWC). At the time of admission, children are often in a state of trauma and require immediate medical attention and psychological counselling. Each child under our custody undergoes a thorough medical examination. We maintain detailed Medical Examination Reports (MERs) and Child Study Reports (CSRs) of each child. Dr. Sricha Sharma, our consulting paediatrician, takes care of all health-related issues, including regular check-ups and immunization of our children.

Mamta is equipped to provide quality, all-round care for infants, toddlers, older children, and children with special needs. Great attention is paid to keep the residential environment clean. The food menu is planned to provide balanced nutrition and taste for all children of ages.

For new-borns and toddlers, a variety of activities are in place to enhance their mental and physical development. Older children who are enrolled in school were unable to attend physical classes due to COVID-19 Pandemic. They were attending online classes with the support of office staff.

Sometimes, children with special needs are also admitted into Mamta. These children are looked after with special care. Rehabilitative therapies are provided to them. Although, they are largely considered 'unadoptable' as they do not find favour with prospective adoptive parents in India.

We are grateful to our band of dedicated volunteers that help us plan exciting and interesting activities for the children on a regular basis.


